
GOA Catch and ABC levels

GOA 2008 ABC's: 536,191 +





- Harvest rate below maximum permissible FABC




Pacific cod survey: 2003 297,402 t




Pacific cod survey: 2005 308,091 t


Pacific cod survey biomass estimates

Pacific cod ABC/TAC considerations

Team agreed, given lack of adequate time for review, any model presentation would serve a limited role in evaluating stock status

 Extensive BSAI cod modeling precluded work on GOA assessment

Team made several requests for presentation of new model in Sept 2008

- Opted for Tier 5 ABC which reflected decline in survey biomass from 2005-2007
- Catch has been almost half of ABC in 2007





The survey abundance index down 14% from 2006


- But increased 13% 2005 and 2006

 - Expected to decline through 2012




NMFS sablefish longline survey




GOA trawl survey sablefish













Flatfish 2007 ABC's 292,375 t combined







Same age/sex structured model


2007 survey biomass and size composition Age data from 2005 survey Updated growth relationship








Slope Rockfish 2008 ABC's 26,029 tons total






Sensitivity to trawl and longline survey indices




Atka mackerel 2005 survey





Atka mackerel

- Tier 6 species
- No directed fishing since 1996
 - Bycatch mainly in rockfish fishery relatively stable
- TAC set to meet incidental catch levels
- Concerns about single year class (1999)
- ABC = 4,700 (TAC=1,500 t)
 - Tier 5 analogue would be 18,120 +

Skates

- In GOA, 2 main target species
 - Big skate (*Raja binoculata*)
 - Longnose skate (Raja rhina)
- 3rd group composed of many species
 - Bathyraja spp.
 - not targeted to date



- SSC reviewed in December 2006
- Include: Squid, sharks, sculpins, octopus, and grenadiers
- Team previously (2006) recommended ABCs and OFLs for amendment analysis
- Some additional Team recommendations for analysis including evaluation of dogfish separately from remaining shark species, and consideration of including squid in forage fish category
